

Anderson High School Lacrosse Player Code of Conduct

It is the stated mission of the Anderson High School Lacrosse Program to provide a positive, competitive lacrosse program for each player, parent and coach. All persons involved in the program are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during and after games, scrimmages and practices. Punishment for player conduct violations will be determined by the Head Coach and reviewed, if deemed necessary, by a committee of Board Members. Penalties may include suspension or expulsion. No fees will be refunded to any player suspended or expelled from the team as the result of a conduct violation(s).

Conduct violations include:

- Abusive, profane, or violent behavior or language at any team function
- Use, distribution or consumption of alcohol, illegal drugs, cigarettes, or unauthorized prescriptions before, during, or after any team activity
- Any behavior or activity that results in suspension from school
- Failure to comply with THSLL code of conduct and rules
- Other behavior that, in the opinion of the head coach, reflects negatively upon the Anderson Lacrosse Program.

League Code of Conduct from THSLL Rule Book

11.0 Improper Behavior

Abusive, profane, or violent behavior or language by coaches, players, or fans at any League function may result in such Team member, coach, player or fan being suspended or expelled. This includes behavior not in conformance with the Purposes of THSLL Rulebook © Copyright – THSLL – 2011 12 www.thsll.org the Texas High School Lacrosse League as stipulated in the TSLA, Inc. Bylaws. Players who are ejected from a game due to unsportsmanlike conduct will serve a one game suspension. The game served will be the next scheduled game on the THSLL website at the time of the ejection. A player who plays on both JV and Varsity will serve the suspension in the next Varsity game he is eligible to play in. If the ejection occurs in the final game of the season, the player will serve the suspension in the first scheduled District game the following season.

No alcoholic beverages or any intoxicating substances or intoxicated individuals are allowed at any League functions. Punishments shall be decided by the Board, and may include sanctions, penalties, suspensions or expulsions of individuals, Teams or Programs from the League or any combination of any of the foregoing.
